Following the discussion it was agreed that the Hartpur Parish Council concerns were the increased traffic volume, the condition and suitability of the roads that will be affected, the need for a crossing on the A417 especially considering the increase in traffic already seen and recent accidents and the lack of infrastructure.

It was agreed the Clerk would collate comments together using both previous comments and new concerns/information including the Glynychbrook Development, these will be circulated to Cllrs ahead of the March meeting for further discussion to take place and comments to be finalised and agreed. It was resolved that no further meetings need to be held but that the information regarding the FoDDC public/open meetings will be made available to the public.
